TEXAS LICENSE TO CARRY HANDGUN LICENSE (LTC) CLASSES: (Formerly known as Concealed Handgun License (CHL))

NRA BASICS OF PERSONAL PROTECTION OUTSIDE THE HOME COURSE:

Comprehensive and intensive in its approach to equip the defensive shooting candidate with the skills needed to survive serious adversity.

The course teaches students the knowledge, skills and attitude essential for avoiding dangerous confrontations and for the safe, effective and responsible use of a concealed pistol for self-defense outside the home. Students have the opportunity to attend this course using a quality strong side hip holster that covers the trigger, or a holster purse. From a review of safe firearms handling and proper mindset to presentation from concealment and multiple shooting positions, this course contains the essential skills and techniques needed to prevail in a life-threatening situation.

NRA BASIC PERSONAL PROTECTION IN THE HOME COURSE:

Teaches the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to the safe and efficient use of a handgun for protection of self and family, and to provide information on the law-abiding individual's right to self-defense.

An eight-hour course. Students shoot approximately 100 rounds of ammunition. Students will learn basic defensive shooting skills, strategies for home safety and responding to a violent confrontation, firearms and the law, how to choose a handgun for self-defense, and continued opportunities for skill development. Students will receive the NRA Guide to the Basics of Personal Protection In The Home handbook, and a course completion certificate.

HOME FIREARM SAFETY:

This is non-shooting course and teaches basic knowledge, skills, and to explains the attitude necessary for the safe handling and storage of firearms and ammunition in the home.

A "must have" class for gun-owners, particularly with children in the home.

NRA FIRST STEPS PISTOL ORIENTATION:

Firearm Instruction, Responsibility, and Safety Training — is the NRA's response to the American public's need for a firearm orientation program for new purchasers.

NRA BASIC PISTOL SHOOTING COURSE:
